There is no single definition of agile. Today,
agile encompasses:

Understand the power of a selforganised team

Recognise that those clo to the work are the people best placed to do it. Greater involvement means team nembers are more likely to own and commit.

Avoid overdoing agile terminology

Don't suddenly talk epics, uon t suddenly talk epic backlogs and spiking to your customers. You can introduce some agile terms but translate them into everyday business language

It can start with looking at

mindset; it's about adjusting,
learning, embracing, and recognising that organisations need to be more responsive to change For instance, agile ways co project management methods - think PRINCE2 Agile®.



Start small Agile isn't an on/off switch. Yo can introduce agile behaviour concepts and techniques incrementally. Be agile – start with one team, experiment, learn, share lessor grow 'agile' experts.
