Overview

PRINCE2°, firmly established as the world's most-practised method for project management, is globally recognized for delivering successful projects.

These courses provide participants with a solid understanding of the PRINCE2 (7th Edition) method covering the principles, practices and processes.

Foundation to Practitioner Certification

The PRINCE2 Foundation qualification is the first of two PRINCE2 qualifications required to become a Registered PRINCE2 Practitioner.

By passing the exam participants can act as an informed member of a project management team using the PRINCE2 methodology within a project environment.

The Practitioner certification is applied learning. Success completion of the exam enables the person to run and manage a project within an environment supporting PRINCE2.

Key topics

The courses explore the following content with the Foundation level focusing on the theory, whilst Practitioner considers the application of the method:

Key concepts of projects and PRINCE2

Definition of a project. What makes a project a PRINCE2 project? Features and benefits of PRINCE2. The customer/supplier context.

PRINCE2 Principles

Understanding and analysis of the PRINCE2 principles. Explain which aspects of a project can be tailored, who is responsible and how tailoring decisions are made.

PRINCE2 People

Projects need people, how the project is established and managed depends on an understanding of the needs, capabilities, and motivations of the participants and the relationships between them.

PRINCE2 Practices

Understand the PRINCE2 practices and how they are applied throughout the project, including business case, organisation, quality, plans, risk, change and progress.

PRINCE2 Processes

The principles, practices, and processes are applied by the people involved to ensure that the method is fit for the project context.


Who is this course for?

- Project managers and aspiring project managers
- Other key staff involved in the design, development and delivery of projects including:
 - Project Board members (e.g. sponsors)
 - · Team Managers
 - Project Assurance
 - Project Support (e.g. Project and Programme Office personnel)
 - Operational line managers/staff

Prerequisites:

- Be project managers or team leaders or have been involved in a project environment
- Understand project terminology and concepts or have completed a <u>project</u> <u>management fundamentals course</u>

Project Environment





The objectives of the Foundation course are to understand:

- Key concepts relating to projects and PRINCE2
- How the PRINCE2 principles underpin the PRINCE2 method
- The PRINCE2 themes and how they are applied throughout the project
- Prepare for the Foundation examination

To ensure your outcomes are achieved both courses require some pre-course preparation. Expected pre-course prep time: 1-2 hours.

For the Foundation course, this will be sent out 2 weeks in advance of the course (or at time of booking if booking less than 2 weeks prior to course commencement).

Course duration:

Weekday course: 3 days Weekend course: 2 days Virtual training: 3 days

The Foundation course is NOT a project management fundamentals course and therefore does not cover the principles of project management.

The Foundation course includes PRINCE2 Foundation Exam which consists of:

- 60 minutes
- 60 multiple-choice questions
- 60% pass mark is (36/60)
- Closed book exam

PDUs & CPDs

Participants who have been awarded the Project Management Professional (PMP)® credential by the Project Management Institute (PMI)[®] are eligible to earn:

- Weekday/Virtual (3 days): 21 PDUs (21 Ways of Working)
- Weekend (2 days): 18 PDUs (18 Ways of Working)

Participants holding any of the Project Management accreditations (CPPP/ CPPM/ CPPD) are eligible to earn 20 CPDs.



The objectives of the Practitioner course are to:

- Apply the PRINCE2 principles
- Apply and tailor relevant aspects of PRINCE2 practices
- Apply and tailor relevant aspects of PRINCE2 processes
- Prepare for the Practitioner examination

Participants joining a PRINCE2 Practitioner course will be issued with pre-course work at the end of the Foundation course to ensure adequate preparation for the Practitioner examination.

Expected pre-course prep time: minimum 4 hours.

To be eligible to sit the PRINCE2 Practitioner examination, participants must have obtained a pass in the PRINCE2 Foundation exam.

Course duration:

- Weekday & Virtual: 2 days
- Weekend: 2 days

Q PeopleCert

Please note that the Practitioner course is an examination preparation course and focuses on the application of PRINCE2 to prepare candidates for the Practitioner examination.

Your certification will need to be renewed within three years of its original certification date. Please, refer to <u>PeopleCert</u> for more information.

The Practitioner course includes PRINCE2
Practitioner Online Exam which consists of:

- Multiple-choice format based on a project scenario
- 70 questions
- 60% pass mark (42/70)
- 150 minutes (2.5 hours) duration
- Open book (Managing Successful Projects with PRINCE2 7th Edition publication permitted – no other materials permitted)

PDUs & CPDs

Participants who have been awarded the Project Management Professional (PMP)° credential by the Project Management Institute (PMI)° are eligible to earn:

Weekday, Weekend & Virtual (2 days):
 14 PDUs (14 Ways of Working)

Participants holding any of the Project Management accreditations (CPPP/ CPPM/ CPPD) are eligible to earn:

- Weekday/Weekend (2 days): 20 CPDs
- Virtual Training (2 days): 20 CPDs for short course or 15 CPDs for certification attained.
